**STATUS ON IMPLEMENTATION OF DELAYED PROJECTS AND PROSPECTS OF  
ARTICLE 5 COUNTRIES IN ACHIEVING COMPLIANCE WITH THE NEXT CONTROL  
MEASURES OF THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL**

This document is issued to:

- **Replace**, the 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet in the Executive Summary as follows:
  - 2008 data reported by eight countries suggest possible non-compliance with the CFC control measures (Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Dominican Republic<sup>1</sup>, Federated States of Micronesia, Iraq, Saudi Arabia, Vanuatu and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of)); halon (Iraq and Vanuatu); methyl bromide (Iraq and Vanuatu); and, CTC control measures (Bolivia, Ecuador, Indonesia, Iraq, Mexico and Turkmenistan).
- **Replace**, for Argentina, the 2008 consumption data for CFCs of 902.3 ODP tonnes **with** 50.8 ODP tonnes, and for methyl bromide of 221.1 ODP tonnes **with** 22.5 ODP tonnes throughout the document UNEP/OzL.Pro/ExCom/58/6.
- **Replace** Table 3 as follows:
